Wedding Photography Permit FAQs

Can I have my wedding photographs taken on the grounds of the Castle?

Yes, a permit is needed; just apply with at least 3 days' notice. It does not cost any fee.

What documents are required?

Before applying (by online form only), please remember that if you are granted permission to have your wedding photographs taken on the grounds of Kilkenny Castle, you must prepare to submit your photographer's public liability insurance

When should I apply?

Photoshoots require a minimum of 3 working days' notice. No late applications are accepted and no provisional bookings can be made.

Once an application is received, a response can be expected in 3 working days. Applications are by online booking form only.

At what times are the photoshoots permitted?

January	09:00 – 16:00 (closing from 15:30)
February	09:00 – 16:30 (closing from 16:00)
March	09:00 – 17:30 (closing from 17:00)
April	08:30 – 19:00 (closing from 18:30)
May, June, July and August	08:30 – 20:30 (closing from 20:00)
September	08:30 – 19:00 (closing from 18:30)
October	09:00 – 17:30 (closing from 17:00)
November	09:00 – 16:30 (closing from 16:00)
December	09:00 – 16:00 (closing from 15:30)

Can I get married on the grounds of Kilkenny Castle?

You cannot currently get married or hold a civil ceremony on the grounds of Kilkenny Castle but you may wish to have your wedding photographs taken there. A permit is needed; just apply with at least 3 days' notice. It does not cost any fee.

However, a number of historic sites cared for by the Office of Public Works, including the Parade Tower at Kilkenny Castle, are available to host civil and humanist ceremonies – for further information click [here](#).

Does it cost money to have wedding photographs taken on the grounds of Kilkenny Castle?

No, wedding photography is free.

Are there rules to use Kilkenny Castle grounds?
